

**Official Rules for *Our State's* eSweepstakes  
April 2010**

**An Art-Infused Weekend in Greater Raleigh  
March 16, 2010 (12:01pm ET) – April 20, 2010 (12 noon ET)**

1. HOW TO ENTER: NO PURCHASE OR PAYMENT OF ANY KIND IS NECESSARY. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING. Enter online beginning at 12:01pm (ET), March 16, 2010 at [www.ourstate.com/extras/esweepstakes.aspx](http://www.ourstate.com/extras/esweepstakes.aspx). Entries must be received by 12 noon (ET) on April 20, 2010. One entry per person or email address.
2. ELIGIBILITY: This Sweepstakes is open to legal residents of the 50 United States and Washington D.C. who are 21 years of age and older as of February 16, 2010, except the employees of the Sponsors (Mann Media, the Greater Raleigh Convention and Visitors Bureau and all of the organizations providing components of this prize package), and members of their immediate families.
3. SELECTION OF WINNER: One (1) winner will be selected at random from all eligible entrants on or about April 20, 2010. The selection will be final and binding in all respects. The odds of winning depend on the number of eligible entries received. The winner will be notified by telephone, mail and/or by email on or about April 20, 2010. Return of any prize notification as undeliverable will result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner. In the event of a dispute about the identity of an entrant, each entry will be declared made by the authorized account holder of the email address submitted at time of entry. The authorized account holder is defined as the natural person who is assigned to an email address by an Internet Service Provider, online access provider or other organization (e.g., business, educational institution, etc.) that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address. With respect to each winning entry, the winner may be required to provide proof that the winner is the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the winning entry.
4. PRIZE: One (1) winner a package featuring two-night, luxury accommodations at the Umstead Hotel and Spa in Cary, N.C.; a personally guided tour of the new North Carolina Museum of Art and a \$20 Museum Store shopping voucher and special commemorative poster; a Taste Carolina Gourmet Food Tour; a visit Cary's Chatham Hill Winery; horse-drawn carriage ride in downtown Raleigh from J&L Carriages; and jazz brunch Irregardless Café. Package is valued at approximately \$800.
5. NO TRANSFERS: No transfers, substitutions in prizes or cash will be allowed except by Sponsor, who may substitute a prize of equal or greater value. Sponsors will not replace any lost or stolen tickets, vouchers, certificates or other prize items once they are in the winner's possession.

Sponsors reserve the right to modify or terminate this Sweepstakes or disqualify any entry in the event of technical impairment by computer virus or otherwise. In the event of early termination, Sponsors will randomly select winners from all eligible entries received at time of termination.
9. RESTRICTIONS: Prize will be delivered to winner only and prize is not transferable.

10. LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY: Sponsors are not responsible for: (1) lost, late, misdirected, undeliverable or incomplete entries due to system errors or failures, or faulty transmissions or other telecommunications malfunctions and/or entries; (2) technical failures of any kinds; (3) failures of any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Sweepstakes; (4) unauthorized human and/or mechanical intervention in any part of the entry process or the Sweepstakes; (5) technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Sweepstakes or the processing of entries; or (6) any injury or damage to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from entrant's participation in the Sweepstakes or receipt or use of any prize. If for any reason an entrant's entry is confirmed to have been erroneously deleted, lost or otherwise destroyed or corrupted, entrant's sole remedy is another entry in the Sweepstakes.
